Why it Matters:

In Florida, the demand for guardianship is rising among vulnerable adults, including older persons, people with intellectual disabilities, mental illnesses and other cognitive impairments.

What is Guardianship:

Guardianship is a legal process where a court appoints a decision-maker for a vulnerable adult who cannot care for themselves, physically, financially, or socially.

Who can join:

EC requires three members: one physician/psychiatrist and others with expertise in gerontology, psychology, nursing, social work, etc.

In the Leon county area, there's a shortage of EC members, especially those from diverse backgrounds.
